The Board's Response to Other Questions, Suggestions, and Comments:

1. There is a trash can at the beginning of Jerry Russom Park. Dog owners are to bring their own bags for picking up after their dogs.
2. Please pick up your dog dropping from neighbor's yards
3. The county vegetation corp. is responsible for cleaning up downed trees in Miller Creek.
4. A stop sign is in place at the corners of Canyon Oak and Upper Oak.
5. A left turn lane from Lucas Valley Road on to Canyon Oak has been discussed with Public Works in anticipation of any further road work in that area.
6. Please cut vegetation that impedes sidewalks and stop signs.
7. Coyote bushes have been cut by city workers!
8. It was suggested that pavement signage be applied on Canyon Oak Dr. to alert drivers that the road will be shared by bikes, pedestrians and cars.
9. The Las Gallinas median strips are maintained by the city twice each year. Herbicides are sometimes used.
10. Please do not run stop signs, even late at night. Residents are being ticketed.
