
The Board of Directors of the Mont-Marín Homeowners Association unanimously voted to oppose the use of Lucas Valley Road as the prime access to the coast. We urge the immediate deletion from the Preliminary Coastal Plan, Hearing Draft, March 1975, the following sentences:

- Page 62 "Lucas Valley Road should be developed and promoted as the prime access a way to the Northern portion of the park complex."
- Page 66 "Some relief of current congestion might be achieved by improvement and advertisement of the more northerly Lucas Valley Road lateral."

We oppose the use of Lucas Valley Road because:

- Highway 101 - Lucas Valley Road interchange is inadequate for more vehicle traffic and in its present congested state is a safety hazard.
- Taxpayer expense to improve the two-lane road is an exorbitant \$1,000,000 per mile over Big Rock.
- Increased traffic will disturb the tranquility of our life styles and the beauty of our open space.

We urge and appreciate immediate action.
