The July 7 Board Meeting was well attended reflecting the concern for managing the fire hazard in our surrounding open spaces. With the community clearly expressing their concerns on this issue, Ari Golan and Brad Mark brought their resources to our neighborhood and cleared the brush in our surrounding wild lands.

Ari Golan, Chief Open Space Ranger, County of Marin returned with the County’s team to clear the open space an additional 30 feet and remove limbs that were lower than 10 feet from the ground on trees behind the properties along Coast Oak, Cedar Hill and Upper Oak.

Bradley Mark, Captain Specialist, San Rafael Fire Department brought in the Delta Crew Team to spend two days clearing brush behind the homes on Salvador Way.

In addition to the open space work in our community, Nader Mansourian, Assistant Public Works Director had his crew clearing out the weeds and trimming the bush along the Las Gallinas Avenue median strip. We thank Steve Egger, Dave Graniss, Steve Elbing and Nick Creschenzi for spending several days clearing out the trash and weeds that were a blight on our neighborhood.
