September 1, 2010 Guest Speaker:

Susan Adams Ph.D. – Supervisor, County of Marin, District 1

- Explained how disaster readiness and supporting each other within the neighborhood community are connected.
- New “Tens System” a nationally recognized emergency notification system used by police/fire to call neighbors in case of a local emergency (recently used for a lost man in the Marinwood and Terra Linda neighborhoods).
- Discussed disaster readiness: Terra Linda had drills with the fire department, Santa Venetia practiced search & rescue; Lucas Valley has facilities for power tools, etc.
- Discussed Measure I regarding combining Marinwood and San Rafael Fire Department and the emergency facility proposed in San Rafael.
- Explained those that combine public partnerships (such as neighborhood associations) with private partnerships are more likely to receive grants, etc., and get things done.
- Discussed Open House Oct. 4, at the new “Marin Health and Wellness Center” at Bellam Ave.
- Discussed the federal grant awarded for the Safe Passage along Lucas Valley Road project.
